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Sustainability meter for neighbourhoods

Ghent

- > Needed for the Tondelier project
- > No national / regional instrument available
- > BREEAM and LEED as inspiration
- > Sustainability meter °2008, update in 2011

Flanders


- > Sustainability meter °2016, update in 2017
- Now also used by City of Ghent

Principles

- > For new neighbourhoods or deep renovation
- > Site level, compatible with building level
- > Objective and transparant
- > Integral approach
- > A step further than regulations
- > Focus on results, not on specific solutions
- > Follow-up throughout the entire process
- > No certificate

Themes and weights

- > Project process
- > Urban planning (20%)
- > Mobility (13%)
- > Natural environment (13%)
- > Water (7%)
- > Materials and waste (7%)
- > Energy (20%)
- > Health, livability and accessibility (13%)
- > Economy and employment (7%)
- > Innovation
- > Management

Preliminary analysis by the City of Ghent


- > Analysis of site qualities and decisions
- > Some criteria are already fulfilled
- > Some criteria cannot be fulfilled / are not applicable
- > Some extra criteria are made mandatory
- > Tender: award criterion on sustainability (20%)
 - Overall score must be >= 65%
 - Extra requirements on energy, water, materials

Public-private partnership agreement

- > Ghent sustainability meter v2008
- > Overall score >= 85% in final stage
- > Shift in criteria scores: OK, as long as overall score is >= 85%
- > Updates and proof at process milestones, e.g. permit application

Follow-up

> Update by private partner +/- once a year



Follow-up

- > Assessment by the City of Ghent:
 - Can an overall score of 85% still be obtained?
 - × Criteria fulfilled or easy to fulfill (about 76%)
 - × Criteria at risk (about 8%)
 - × Criteria with potential (about 2% innovation)
 - Discussion of problems and compensation: e.g.
 - × Asphalt vs concrete
 - × Sustainable wood

Lessons learned

- > Use as a base for discussion, no need for certification
- > Long duration of projects vs fixed instrument: how to take new regulations or insights into account?
 - E.g. passive buildings vs NZE buildings
- > Integration within private partner's team → who is responsible?
- > Less enthusiasm of private partner after the tender phase → enforcement?
